

Crochet Rag Rug Bag



Instructions

1. Prepare tapes cut from gingham check and sheeting.

2. rnd 1: With gingham tape, ch 1, sc 6 into adjustable ring. Pull the yarn end to complete ring. Join with sl st in beg ch. (6 sc)
 rnd 2: ch 1, *sc 2 in same st; rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch.(12 sc)
 rnd 3: ch 1, *sc 1, (sc 2 in same st); rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch. (18 sc)
 rnd 4: ch 1, *sc 2, (sc 2 in same st); rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch. (24 sc)
 rnd 5: ch 1, *sc 3, (sc 2 in same st); rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch. (30 sc)
 rnd 6: ch 1, *sc 4, (sc 2 in same st); rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch. (36 sc)
 rnd 7: ch 1, *sc 5, (sc 2 in same st); rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch. (42 sc)
 rnd 8: ch 1, *sc 6, (sc 2 in same st); rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch. (48 sc)
 rnd 9: ch 1, *sc 7, (sc 2 in same st); rep from* around, join with sl st in beg ch. (54 sc)

3. rnds 10-19: ch 1, sc 54 around, join with sl st in beg ch.

Needles

- Amour Crochet Hook(10.0 mm)
(Art No. 1057)

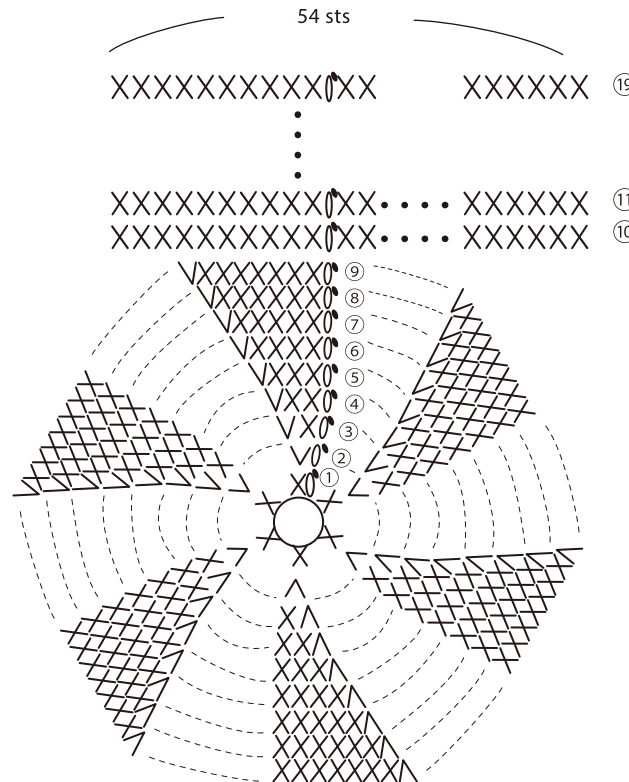
Notions

- Darning needle

Materials

- Tape made from gingham check
(92 cm width: 2 m) cut to 2 cm width
- Tape made from red sheeting
(88 cm width: 70 cm) cut to 2 cm width

- ch (chain stitch)
- X sc (single crochet)
- ∨ single crochet 2 stitches in same stitch
- sl st (slip stitch)

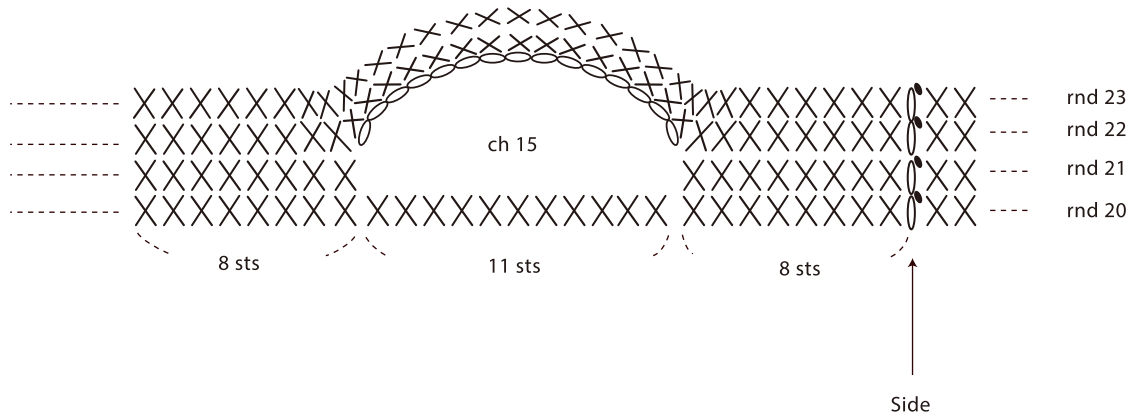


rnds 21-23	Handle part
rnd 20	Change tape, no stitch increase or decrease
rnds 10-19	No stitch increase or decrease
rnd 9	sc 54 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 8	sc 48 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 7	sc 42 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 6	sc 36 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 5	sc 30 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 4	sc 24 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 3	sc 18 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 2	sc 12 sts (+6 sts)
rnd 1	sc 6 sts

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4. rnd 20: Change to sheeting tape, ch 1, sc 54 around, join with sl st in beg ch.

5. rnd 21: ch 1, *sc 8, sk 11 sc, ch 15 in next st, sc 8; rep from * one more time, join with sl st in beg ch.
 rnd 22: ch1, sc around, join with sl st in beg ch.
 rnd 23: rep rnd 22. Cut yarn and weave in ends.



Preparation for Crochet Rag Rug / Let's make tape from fabric

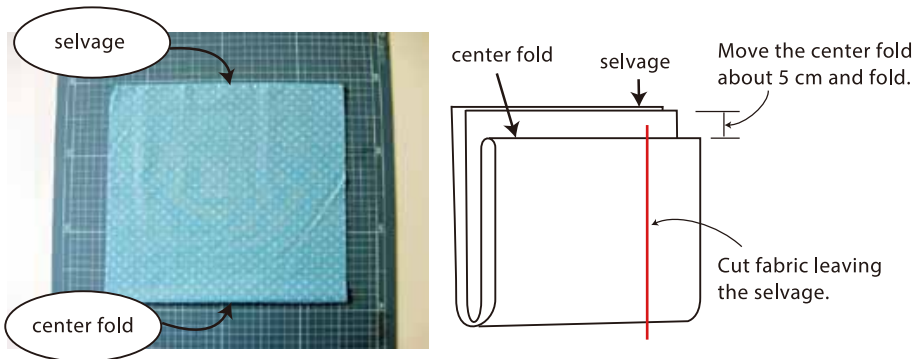
Notions

- Rotary Cutter(45 mm),
Cutting mat, Ruler, Scissors

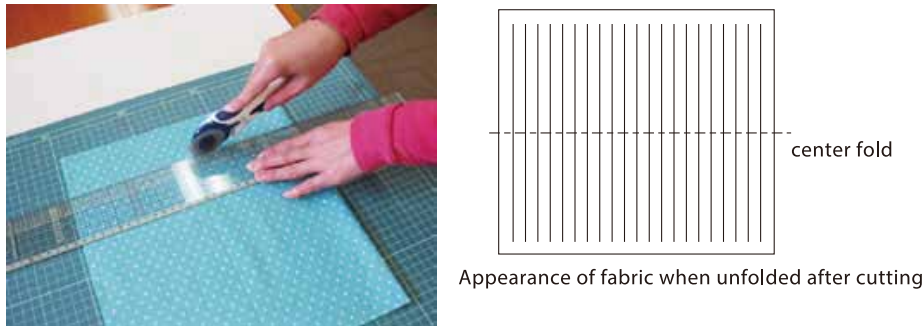
Materials

- Sheeting or gingham, etc.

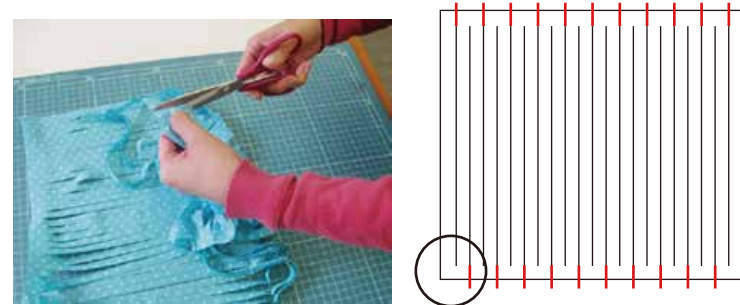
1. Place the fabric on the cutting mat. We have used cut cloth here, but if you use a large piece of fabric, fold it into four and move the center fold from the selvage as shown.



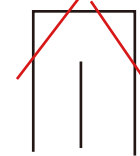
2. Using the scale marked on the cutting mat, cut fabric to the desired width. Leave 2-3 cm of selvage without cutting. The fabric unfolded after cutting will appear as shown.



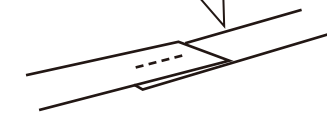
3. With scissors, cut top and bottom of selvage alternately to create yarn-like strands.



4. Cutting the corners will create a tidier finish when worked.



To join tapes, put one end over another and sew together.



5. Wind the tape roughly. Winding alternately with the left and right hand is less likely to result in twisting.
