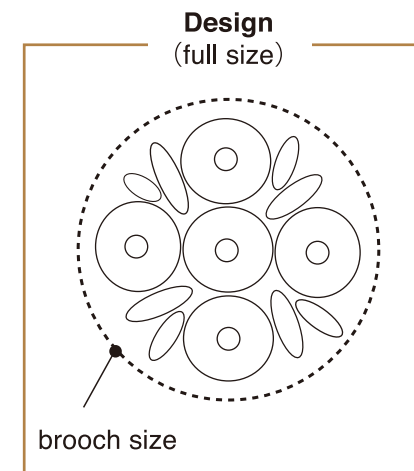
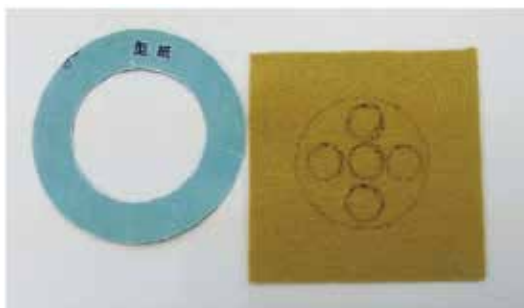


# Small Woolen Embroidered Bouquet Brooch

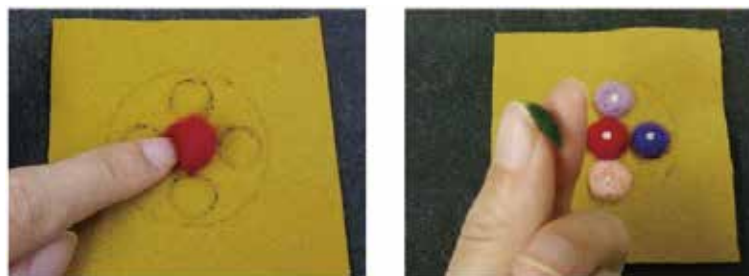


## Instructions

1. Following the diagram, draw a circle and outline the floral shapes with an Erasable Marker.



2. With the circle drawn as a guide – apply Natural Wool Roving with the Single Needle Felting Tool . Use Natural Wool Roving to roll into a ball slightly larger than the circles you have drawn, place down and punch from the outlines.
3. When the outer flower ring (circular part) has been punched, start embroidering the flower core at the center of the flower.
4. Next embroider the leaves. Tear off pieces of Natural Wool Roving, roll it into a slender shape with your fingers, and then punch it to fill the spaces between the flowers.



5. Attach a band or brooch pin to complete the design.

## Tools

- Single Needle Felting Tool
- Needle Felting Mat
- Erasable marker
- Patchwork Scissors (Mini)

## Materials

- Natural Wool Roving
- Fabric (cotton, sheer furano fabric etc.)  
Approx. 7 cm square.
