

Ribbon flower greeting card



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Materials

- 0.5cm width organza ribbon, blue, sky-blue, white; 180 cm each
- 0.4mm pearl beads x 27
- White cotton thread
- Blank greeting card, 15 cm x 15 cm
- Double-sided tape
- Tracing paper

Tools

- Mni Flower Loom (Art No. 3139) <square>
- All purpose sewing needle
- Craft knife
- Metal ruler
- Self-heal cutting mat
- Scissors

Steps

1. Prepare flower, following the basic instruction given in leaflet. Wind ribbon around pegs once. Use white cotton thread for sewing flower centre. Using the same thread, sew 3 pearl beads on the right side of flower centre and make a finishing knot at back of flower. Leave a long thread. Prepare 9 flowers the same way, 3 in each colour.
2. Cut tracing paper to 10 cm x 10cm. Prepare 2 pieces.
3. Arrange and sew flowers evenly to one of tracing paper.
4. Make a window of 8 cm x 8cm in blank greeting card, cutting 3.5 cm away from each edge.
5. Attach double-sided tape all around window edge on inner side of card. With right side facing out, stick first tracing paper with flowers sewn in place.
6. Attach double-sided tape around window edge on inner side of card again. Stick other tracing paper to cover back side of flowers.

Hair pins/Organza bags

Materials to make one

- 0.5cm width organza ribbon, 100 cm
- 0.4mm pearl beads x 3
- White cotton thread
- Plain hair pin/ 7 x 7cm pre-made organza bags

Tools

- Mni Flower Loom (Art No. 3139) <square>
- All purpose sewing needle
- Scissors

Steps

1. Make flower with mini flower loom as for the greeting card. Wind ribbon twice around pegs.
2. Sew flower onto hair pin/organza bag.
