

# Flower Purse Bag

## Tools

- “QUICK” Yo-Yo Maker (Flower-Shape/Large)
- “QUICK” Yo-Yo Maker (Small)
- Scissors
- Sewing needle



## Materials

- Plain Cotton: Per each flower, about 14 cm square cloth (flower petal pieces) + 5 cm diameter cloth for the flower center.
- (For required quantities, please refer to the “Cloth variety and number of flowers” table below.)
- Thread: sturdy thread such as quilt thread
- Handicraft cotton wool: appropriate quantity

### Cloth type and number of flowers

Use cloth with your favourite pattern

	Cloth for the petal portion (approx. 14 cm square)	Cloth for the flowercentre portion (diameter approx. 5 cm)	Number of flowers
1	Pink and White Stripe	Pink and White Gingham Cheque (Small)	1
2	Pink and White Gingham Cheque (Medium)	Plain Pink	2
3	Light Pink and White Gingham Cheque (Small)	Pink and White Gingham Cheque (Medium)	1
4	Pink Polkadots on White background	Pink and White Gingham Cheque (Small)	1
5	Pink and White Gingham Cheque (Small)	Plain Pink	1

## Drawstring bag

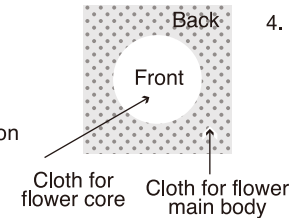
- Exterior cloth (linen cloth) ... Approx. 90 cm x Approx. 30 cm
- Lining (plain cotton) ... Approx. 90 cm x Approx. 30 cm

## Instructions for making the flower

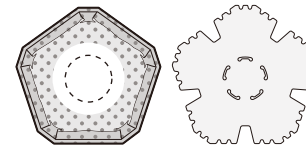
1. Cut out the cloth for the central portion of the flower (about 5 cm in diameter).
2. As shown in the Yo-Yo Maker (Flower) instructions #1, put the main cloth and disc on top of the plate. Then place the flowercenter cloth you have cut in step 1 over the flower main body cloth.



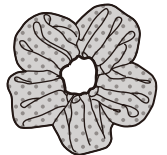
4. Pack handicraft cotton wool into the reverse side of the flower center piece, as shown in steps 14, 15.



3. Follow the instructions up to step 13.

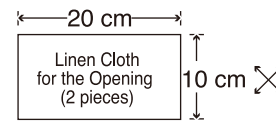
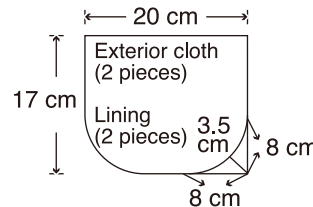


5. As shown in step 18, shape the flower core so that it looks to be at the center to finish it off.

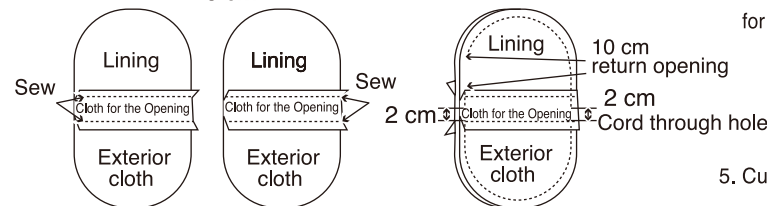


## Purse Instructions

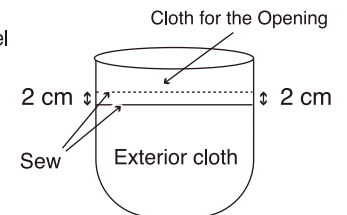
\*1 cm margin for seam allowance not included.



\*The piece in the diagram above is cut along the bias.



3. Clip seams on the curved corners, and press all seams open using Mini Iron. Turn bag right side out through the gap in the lining and blindstitch the gap closed.
4. Turn the lining down inside the bag. Sew a line of stitching around the opening of the bag above and below the gaps in the opening. This will create a channel for the cord.



1. Sew the exterior and lining pieces to the opening pieces, right sides together. Press the seam allowances away from the opening pieces.
2. Place the two pieces together, right sides together and sew around the circumference. Leave a 2 cm gap in each side of the opening piece for the cord, and leave a 10 cm gap in the lining to turn the bag right side out. (Use backstitch at the beginning and end of stitching.)

5. Cut two 60 cm cords.
6. Pass the cord through and conceal it with the Yo-Yo Maker (Small). Using handicraft cotton wool, make ball shapes on either hand and it is complete.
