

Doily with fabric Strips



Instructions

Row 1: Creating a single ring by stitching 3 chain stitch up , 1 chain stitch. length braids, do one chain stitch and repeat it 7 times, pull out the chain stitch that is popping out. Pull the end of the yarn to make it a circle.

Row 2: Continue to pull out the next chain stitch, 3 chain stitch up , 1 chain stitch. As shown in the figure, 1 chain stitch will go around it one after another.

Row 3: 1 chain stitch up, crochet a single crochet. 3 chain stitch, repeat the single crochet. At that time, single crochet. crochet around wrapping the Front of the chain stitch.

Leave about 10 cm excess yarn before cutting. Take the tapestry needle and run the tail end through a section of the finished area. Slide back and forth under the stitches 2 or 3 times to prevent the yarn from sticking out.

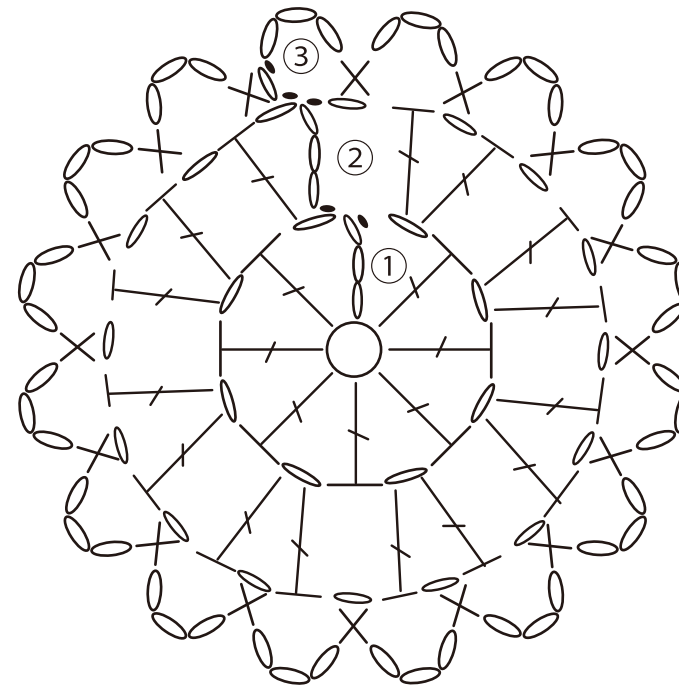
Finished Size : Diameter Approx. 11 cm

Tools

- Amour Crochet Hook (7.0 mm) (Art No. 1054)
- Darning Needle

Materials(For 1 piece)

- Sheeting (88 cm x 25 cm) cut into 1 cm.



- ch (chain stitch)
- sc (single crochet)
- dc(double crochet)
- sl st (slip stitch)

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Finished Size : Diameter Approx. 19 cm

Tools

- Amour Crochet Hook (7.0 mm) (Art No. 1054)
- Darning Needle

Materials(For 3 pieces)

- Sheeting (88 cm x 30 cm) cut into 1 cm.

Instructions

Rows 1 and 2: Stitch the same way as the one on “C-46 1/2” . Do row 3 the same however towards the end, do one chain stitch, then a half double crochet to complete the stitch.

Row 4: 1 chain stitch up, single crochet, 4 chain stitches.Repeat. Finish the row with 2 chain stitches and a half double crochet.

Row 5: 1 chain stitch up, single crochet, 2 chain stitches, 3 chain stitch picots, 2 chain stitches. Repeat.Finish the row with a slip stitch.

Leave about 10 cm excess yarn before cutting. Take the tapestry needle and run the tail end through a section of the finished area. Slide back and forth under the stitches 2 or 3 times to prevent the yarn from sticking out.
