


# **Hair Pin Lace: Round motifs**



### **Tools**

- Hair Pin Lace Tool (Art No. 3104)
- Soft Touch Crochet Hook 2.0 mm (Art No. 1001/2.0) or Amour Crochet Hook 2.0 mm (Art No. 1050/2.0)
- Darning needle

### **Materials**

Light fingering/3 ply cotton yarn (85 m/25 g): leftovers

## Stitch Key

**0** = ch

X = SC

= s s s1


7) = picot

= cut yarn

#### Instructions

Α

- 1. Set loom to 3 cm width and make a strip with 48 loops on each side and with a center single crochet. Form a round and, using the darning neddle, close it with some stitches.
- 2. For the center of the motif, join groups of 4 loops with 12 single crochet stitches starting with a chain and ending with a slip stitch.
- 3. Edge the motif with chains and single crochet stitches in groups of 6 loops as shown.
- 4. Fasten off and weave in ends.






# Hair Pin Lace: Round motifs

В.

- Set loom to 3 cm width and make a strip with 48 loops on each side and with a center single crochet.
  Form a round and, using the darning neddle, close it with some stitches.
- 2. For the center of the motif, join groups of 2 loops with 24 single crochet stitches starting with a chain and ending with a slip stitch.
- 3. Edge the motif with a single crochet in each loop as shown, starting with a chain and ending with a slip stitch.
- 4. Fasten off and weave in ends.



С

- Set loom to 3 cm width and make a strip with 48 loops on each side and with a center single crochet.
  Form a round and, using the darning neddle, close it with some stitches.
- 2. Tie together all the central loops.
- 3. Edge the motif with chains, single stitches and picots as shown, joining groups of 6 loops, starting with a chain and ending with a slip stitch.
- 4. Fasten off and weave in ends.
