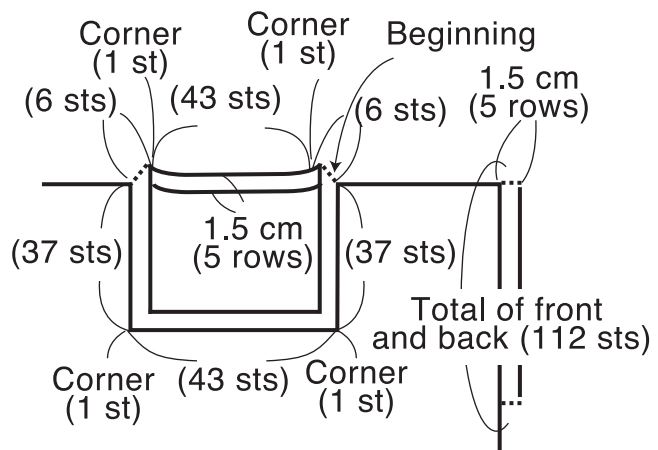


## Edging

Crochet hook 2.25 mm

\*Refer to the specific chart for the knitting method.

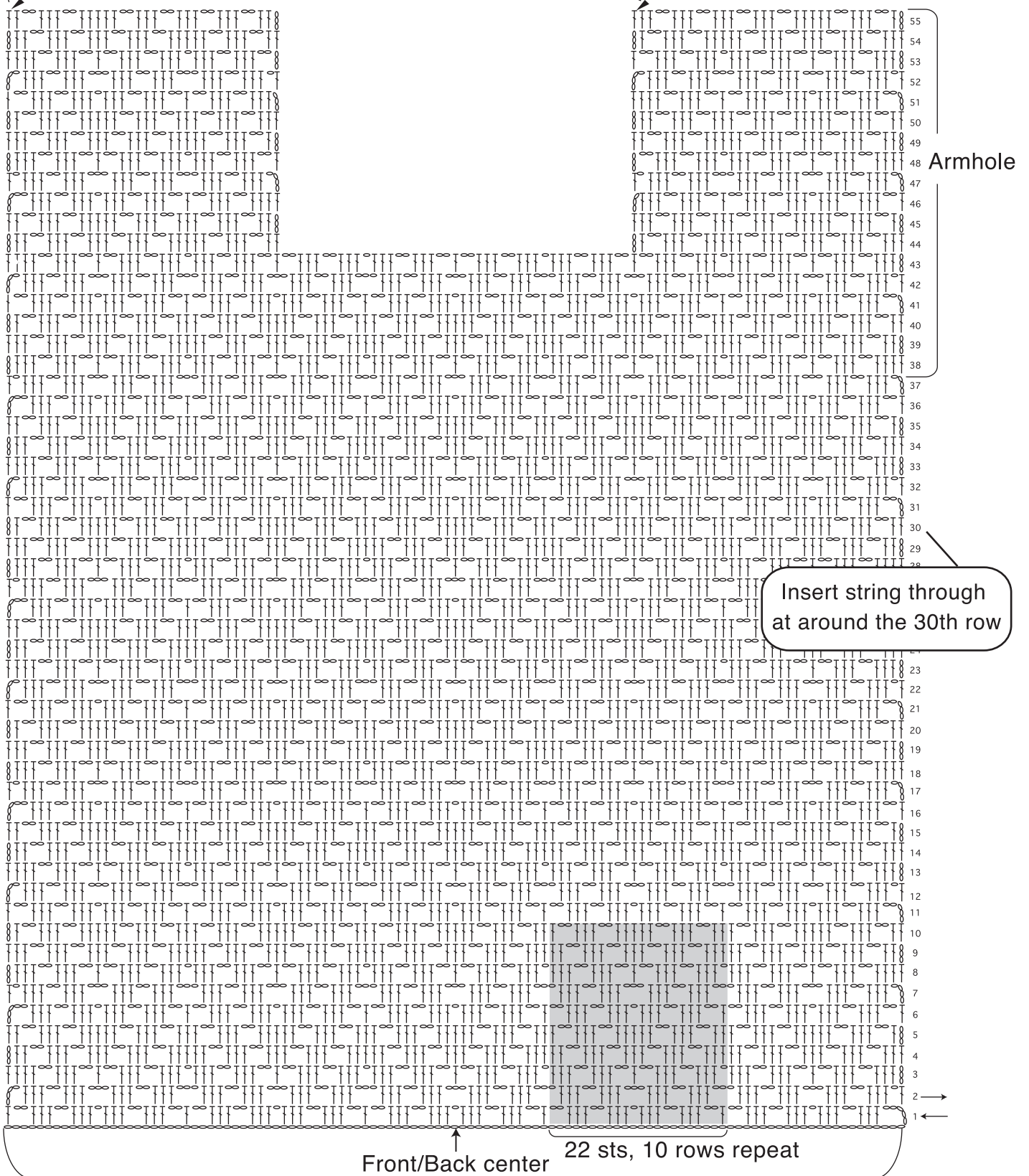


# Zigzag Patterned Tunic

Front

Cut yarn at front right side

Cut yarn at front left side

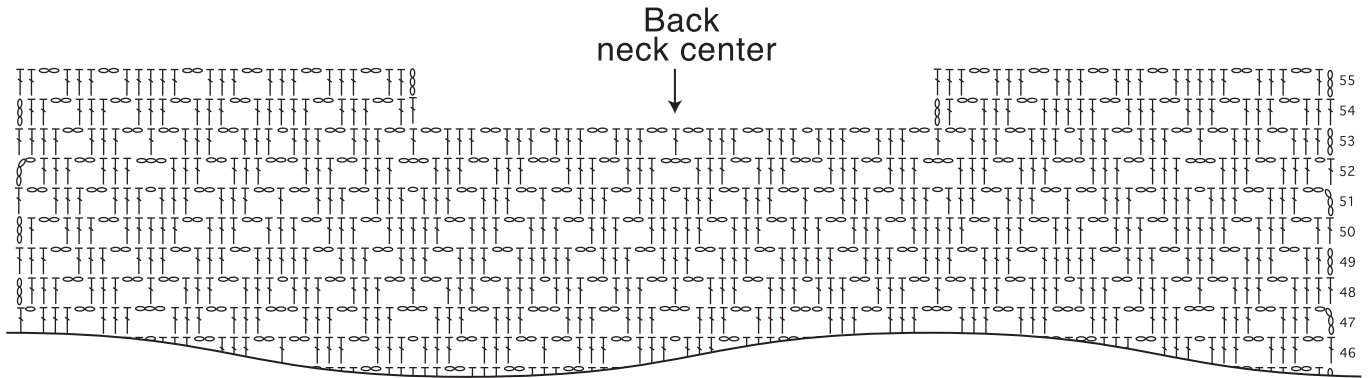


Insert string through at around the 30th row

Front/Back center 22 sts, 10 rows repeat

Foundation chain (111 sts) 5 patterns

Back



**Stitch key  
(Crochet)**

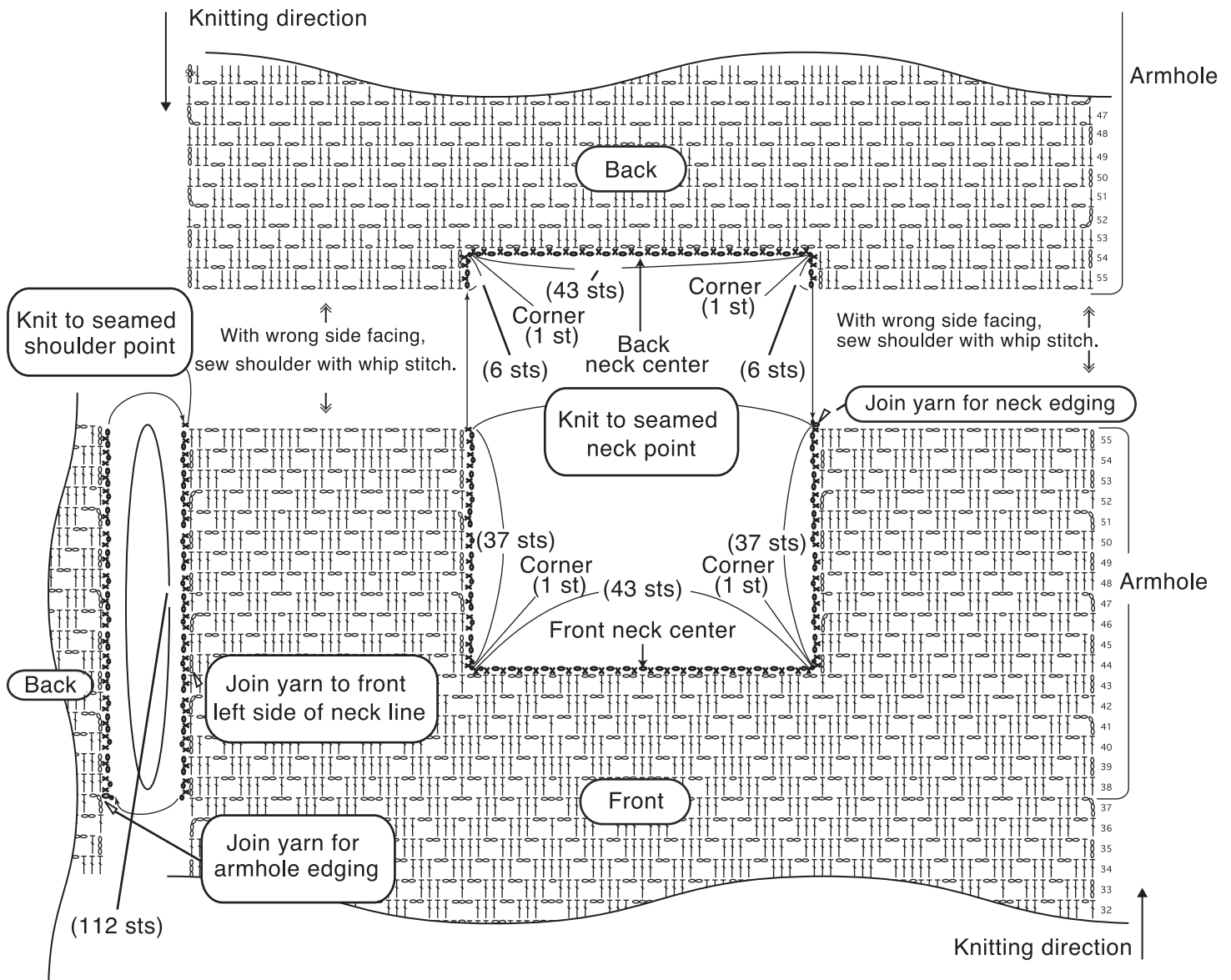
x = sc (single crochet)    o = ch (chain stitch)    † = dc (double crochet)    • = sl st (slip stitch)

$\wedge$  = (single crochet 2 stitches together)  
 (Decrease 1 st)

$\wedge$  = (single crochet 3 stitches together)  
 (Decrease 2 sts)

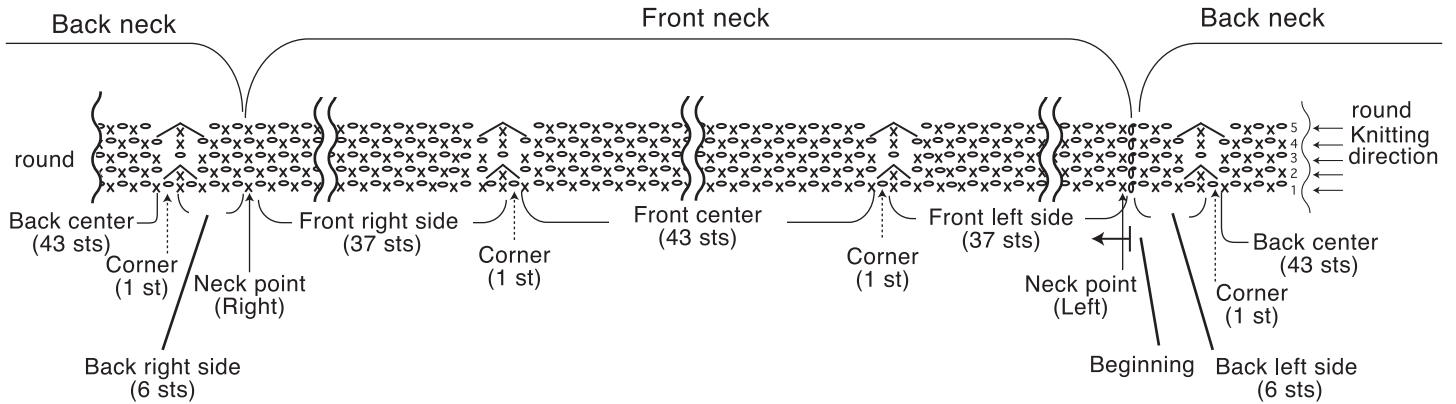
## How to pick up stitches for neck edging and armhole edging

\*Refer to the specific chart for the knitting method and how to reduce corners.



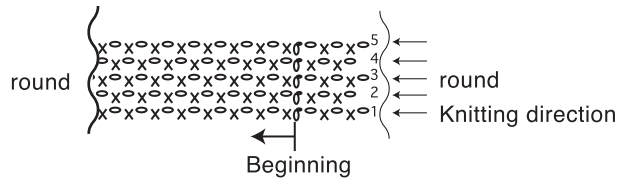
## Neck edging

## Instructions

### 4. String

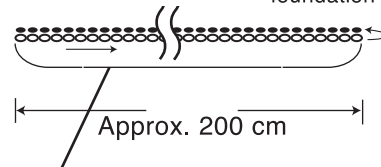
Approx. ch 500, insert hook into back bump, yo, pull through loop, rep to end.

Insert string through around the 30th row as shown in the chart.
