

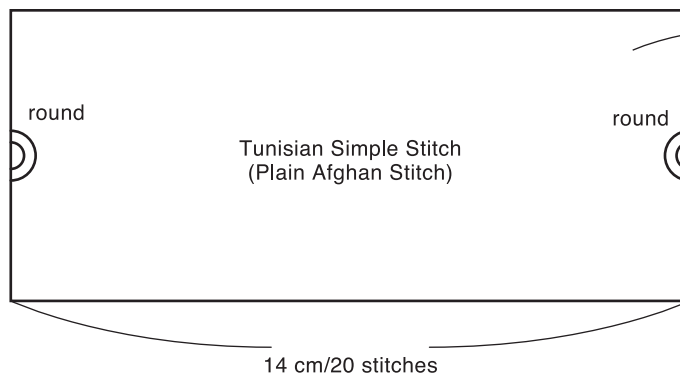
# Tunisian Crochet: Hair Ribbon



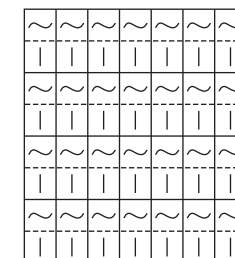
## Instructions

1. Start with yarn A make 20 foundation chains, sl st in first ch make it round without twisting. Continue with same colour make tss in each foundation chain. Continue working with yarn B on reverse row. Pay attention to colour changes. You may put marker at the first stich of the row.
2. Finish off with a row of sl st and weave in ends.
3. Attach to a hair band and using the sock weight yarn pinch the middle of the piece into a ribbon shape. Wrap the thread around the center. Fasten and weave in ends when complete.

## Materials

Two types of wool

- Yarn A: Sock Weight Yarn (53 m/20 g) (5.5 m)
- Yarn B: Bulky Weight Yarn (76 m/40 g) (4 m)

\*Color: personal preference

- Hair band

## Tools

- Double Ended Tunisian Crochet Hook (5.00 mm) (Art No.1306/H)
- Stitch marker
- Darning needle
